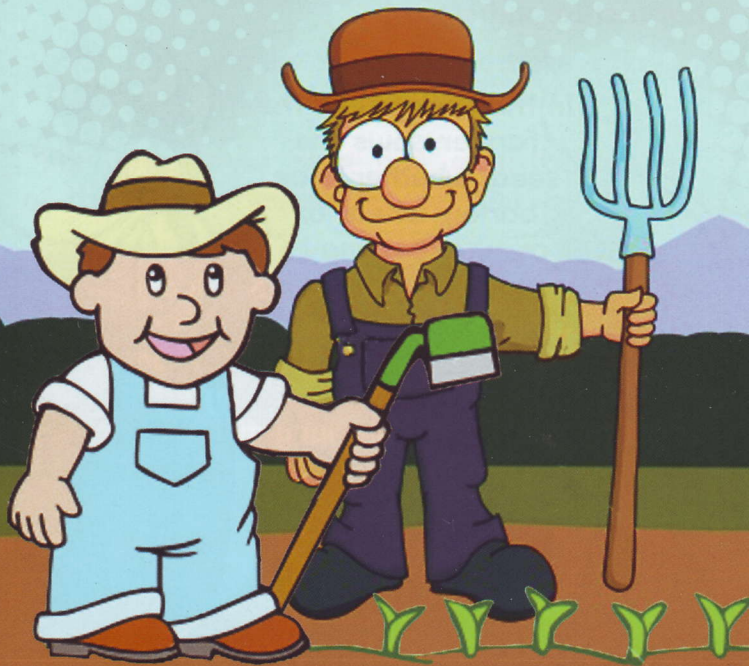


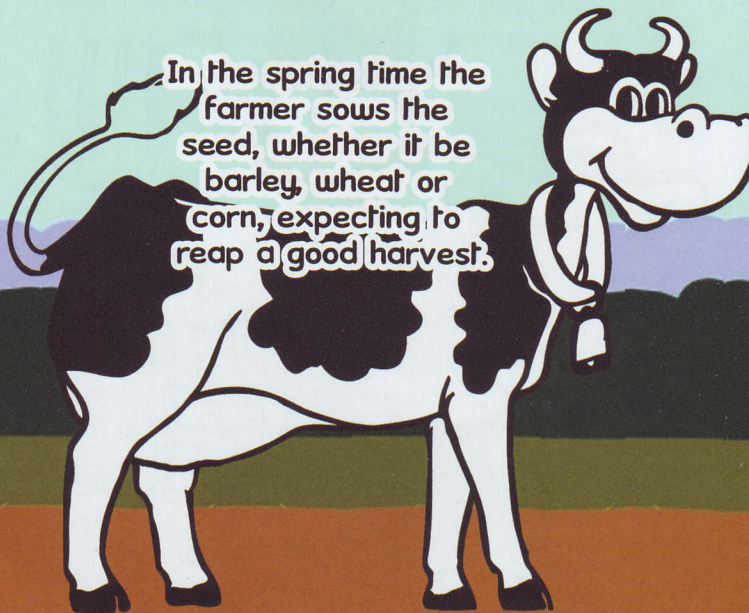
The Farmer

Isaiah 55:6

If you want to be saved from sin and ask the Lord Jesus into your heart, here is a prayer that will help you do that. Remember saying the prayer won't save you; you must really mean what you say with all your heart.

Prayer:

Dear Lord, I am a sinner. Please forgive me for all my sin. I'm really sorry for all the wrong things I have done. Thank you for dying on the cross to save me. I believe in you. Please come into my heart and live now and save me. Help me to live for you every day.
