OVER THE YEARS I get asked many questions, especially from the children. Two of the most frequent questions are, why do you do what you do and do you enjoy what you do? I can honestly say, that after almost 20 years in full-time children's ministry, I do what I love and absolutely love what I do!

During this time I have had the joy, privilege and honour of reaching tens of thousands of children for God. My greatest passion in life is teaching the Bible to children and encouraging them to commit their lives to God at a young age, before the world tries to form them in its mould.

Under the banner of Hope for Youth Ministries, Joanna and I have conducted over 1,000 missions, camps and Bible Clubs all over Northern Ireland - which is possibly a world record! This has given us the opportunity to proclaim the Gospel message in over 400 schools.

In addition to labouring at home, the ministry has taken over 75 teams on international mission trips - 50 of which have been to Poland, Joanna's home country. Reaching children for God gives us much joy, happiness and contentment, but we recognise that without the scores of people who have prayed for and supported us in many diverse ways this could not happen for which we are very thankful. We do not receive a salary or help from government grants, but the Lord faithfully meets all our needs through His generous people. We also want to thank God for granting us good physical health, protection on the roads and an army of committed volunteers who go far beyond the call of duty!

We pray as you read this special milestone magazine which gives a comprehensive overview of the ministry, your heart will be warmed as you see how God is still extending His kingdom today and like us, you will give Him the glory and praise He deserves!


"OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS




TOLLYMORE CAMPS

This remains the highlight of our year. Our traditional camp in Tollymore, where around 200 children, youth and leaders all come to the forest and enjoy an amazing camp. Hundreds of children have attended these camps over the years. Many return as junior and then senior leaders. Children have got saved every year at these camps.

In the heart of God's creation, saturated in the Word of God, not to mention the camp food and fun, makes it one of the most enjoyable and memorable experiences in a child's life. We put up a large Tent for the meals and meetings and a dozen or more small army tents and this becomes home for the children for a week. It's all about impacting a child for God and eternity.







BALMORAL SHOW



On several occasions we have been to Balmoral Show to give out hundreds of gospel goodie bags to kids. These were a great success and it was really encouraging to meet lots of children from around the country who remembered us from visiting their school.



BRACELETS

CHILDREN LOVE BRACELETS. Some hold on to them for years. Two orders of 20,000 special gospel bracelets have been placed in the last few years. They are encouraged to explain what the colours mean to at least three people amongst their friends and family. Black teaches us about the sin we are born with. Red represents the precious shed blood of the Lord Jesus Christ that washes away our sin. White represents a pure clean heart after sin has been forgiven. Green is like grass that reminds us of growth and how it is important to read and pray every day. Gold is for heaven, where the child of God will one day reside forever.

POLAND

With Joanna coming from Poland, this mission field is very close to our hearts. Poland is also the most popular international mission station for us as we team up with Henryk and other Polish leaders from right across Poland. We have taken over 50 teams to Poland since 2007 to conduct camps for poor and disadvantaged children, many of whom are orphans. Thousands of children have benefited from these camps, whilst hundreds of volunteers, young and old have served on these teams over the years, many on several occasions.




In 2016 we returned to Kenya on a mission trip speaking in lots of public schools. We also visited a mission station as well as enjoying a safari.





JAMAICA

In the year 2000, we pastored a church in Little London, Jamaica. This included driving the bus for nine hours on Sunday as well as preaching twice. We had Sunday School, prayer meetings, Bible studies and school ministry, as well as kids and youth meetings. We also enjoyed camps and outings with the youth. Over the year we visited and spoke in 52 schools in Jamaica. The highlight of the week was on a Monday when we would relax on Negril beach by the beautiful Caribbean Sea.

IN JANUARY 2018, we returned to the place in Jamaica where we lived for one year all those years ago. Amazingly, it felt as if nothing had changed. The young people in the church then were now the parents and leaders of the church. It was really encouraging to see them still going on with God. The little bus that we drove for the church those years ago was still driving. We used it to transport our team around the island as we visited and spoke in 56 public schools, witnessing to thousands of Jamaican children and young people.



AUSTRALIA

Spending three years in Australia from 2002-2005 was an amazing experience. Here we enjoyed pulpit ministry as we pastored a church in Lock, South Australia for the first two years. During this time we helped plant a church 60 miles away and start a children's ministry, Bible study and prayer meeting, in addition to a Sunday service. A man at this place, Elliston, was converted on the first Sunday and is going on strong in the Lord to this very day. During our third year, we travelled all over Australia speaking in 100 schools. We bought a camper van for this ministry and after the year sold it for more than we bought it for! We finished our time in Tasmania, helping to establish a children's and youth ministry in another church.




CHINA

Noel Stevenson is our link in the Philippines.


We have now been there three times visiting Noel and helping with the work, wherever the help is needed.
































TRACTS


We now have written and published 100 different tracts for children. In nearly every Bible club and mission we do, the children receive a gospel tract every day. These clearly present the gospel and they have helped many children to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ as their own and personal Saviour.

Often several thousand tracts are given out every week. We now have printed over 1 million tracts for children.



BOOKS
